- A Selkirk received 4200 acres from the government; 1200 in his own right and 200 each in rights of the original 15 heads of families in 1803
- B Selkirk re-granted 900 acres to 17 landholders, less 50 acres re-conveyed to him by Allan MacDougald for debt. By 1809, lots were owned by the two sons of the late John MacDougald, Sr.; the two sons of the late Angus MacDonald of Oronsay; Alexander MacPherson, son of Angus; John MacDonald, son of Peter; Hugh MacCallum, son of Donald; John MacDonald, piper, son of Alexander, piper; and Angus MacDonald, son of Donald.
- C Selkirk appropriated 1250 acres to an additional 25 landholders between 1806 and 1809. Thirteen new men arrived at the settlement during this time.
- D Selkirk also sought an appropriation of 5000 acres for the additional 25 heads of families placed on 50-acre farms as indicated in (C).
- E A. Selkirk petitioned for, and received, an additional 2200 acres in right of 11 more heads of families in 1818.
